

JIMOCO CAFE & PASTA

This Coquitlam spot known for their hearty Korean Italian fusion pastas may be a neighbourhood classic over a decade old, but it was my first time here. The main draw- delicious fusion pastas, with only 1 menu item over \$20!

My friend and I opted for the Beef Rose and Truffle Oil Cream pastas, and a Margherita pizza. While the pizza was nothing to write home about, the pastas were both excellent. The Beef Rose with a little spicy and very hearty with that fusion flavor, while the Truffle Oil Cream was well, a truffle and mushroom lover's dream with a rich creamy white sauce.

KIOKU KITCHEN

A charming Japanese fusion restaurant with only a single menu item over \$20? In this economy? Absolutely. I went to check out Kioku Kitchen in New West, and this is one of the few times the IG hype wasn't wrong. The portions were generous and we ordered way more than enough for two people.

With skillfully seared aburi, overflowing inari pockets and a massive salmon ochazuke, we'd say this place is well worth the drive. The Popcorn Prawn Fry appetizer was nothing to sneeze at either.

How to play:

Your main attacker is Tankaton ex with its attack, Big Hammer, that does 30 damage for each card in your hand. This lets you play many draw cards like Nemona, Roark, Norman, and even Tinkaton.









Setting up:

You mainly want to play Mimikyu as your starting active Pokemon to set up your Tinkatink and evolve it to Tinkaton ex using Rare Candies on your bench and draw many cards to max out Tinkaton ex's damage. Use Arceus Vstar to get any two cards depending on the situation









Strengths:

This deck has no damage cap and can consistently 1KO big Pokemon as long as you have enough cards in your hand

Weakness:

This deck suffers from Iono, as it resets your hand down to how many prize cards you have remaining


